




Scan the unique QR code located on the back of the device and follow all in-app instructions to finish activating your Hub.

NOTE: QR code and serial number can also be found on the original packaging.


Start-Up Operation



1.) Power ON the Hub by pressing and releasing the function button; the status LED will start blinking green.

2.) Upon successful completion of the power ON process an alert will be sent to the Skyhawk CE application.

Shutdown Operation




1.) Power OFF the Hub by pressing and releasing the function button; the status LED will start blinking red.

2.) Upon successful completion of the power OFF process an alert will be sent to the Skyhawk CE application.

Battery Replacement

IMPORTANT: Always replace batteries with 3 new and identical name-brand high quality AA lithium batteries, like an Energizer Advanced or Ultimate Lithium battery should be used.




Battery Replacement

It does not extend to any subsequent owner or other transferee of the Product.

What Does the Limited Product Warranty Cover?

This limited warranty covers defects in materials and workmanship of the Product for the Warranty Period as defined below.

What Does the Limited Product Warranty NOT Cover?
